#### **IMPORTANT NOTICES**

#### Car park users

You will know that we have been concerned with safety in the school car park and that we have recently installed two further speed humps in an effort to reduce speed.

Unfortunately, excess speed is still a problem, particularly at Breakfast Club drop off time. We have now added 'SLOW' signs to the car park and would ask that all users observe a 5mph speed limit (walking pace) for the safety of children, staff, parents and visitors.

We have also added a yellow box junction in front of the black gates by the Children's Centre. Please keep this area clear at all times; if the area is blocked then we cannot get the minibuses in and out and, more importantly, emergency vehicles cannot access the back of the site.

We have painted a yellow box junction in the area of the KS1 green gates and would ask that all parents avoid standing/waiting in this area. It is difficult for staff members to keep track of children coming and going if this area is crowded.
