# **Family Support services**

**ADHD support** for parents/ carers—meets first Monday of each month 10am—12pm. Get information, support and hear from specialist guest speakers.

**Parents SEND support forum** meets third Friday of each month 10am—12pm. Get support, information and advice and hear from guest speakers on a variety of topics.

**Community Coffee morning** for parents/ carers of babies & toddlers. Meets each Tuesday 10.45am—12.15pm. Have a chat over a coffee/tea, get support and a chance for the little ones to make friends & play!

**The Mix**— meets each Wednesday 4.30pm—6pm. A family fun session for children with any additional need, whether diagnosed or not, siblings and parents—activities may include art & craft, sports, games, visiting entertainers.

**MegaMonday**— meets the third Monday of each month a session in our softplay arena 4.30pm—6pm. A chance for children with any additional need, whether diagnosed or not and their siblings to have fun!

**Twins & More**—meets first and third Thursday of the month 1pm—3pm. A play session for twins and multiples and their parents/carers.

**Down Syndrome group**—meets the first Thursday of each month 10am—11.30am. A group for parents/carers of babies and pre-schoolers with Down Syndrome to meet, chat, get information and advice—and for the little ones to make friends and play! Supported by preschool specialist SEND teachers.

Parentalk—the Primary Years and Parentalk—the Teenage Years—two courses for parents/carers to come together, get support, ideas and information around topics such as communication, boundaries & battles, discipline, encouraging independence and making wise choices. These courses run at regular intervals throughout the year, please contact the Family Team for further information/dates.

**One to one individual support**—for families/parents/carers who need a little extra emotional support, a listening ear, someone to help if things are tough or if a family is going through a difficult time.

**Dads & Kids Club**—Saturday mornings 10am—12pm—a chance for fathers (& father figures) and their children aged between 5–11 to meet, have fun, play games & sports.

All our services are free for families/parents/carers.

Our groups are term time only but sometimes we arrange extra activities/family meet ups for school holidays, please get in touch for details.
